WHSCC INVESTIGATES FATALITY AT CANAPORT LNG SITE

Saint John, NB: The Workplace Health, Safety and Compensation Commission (WHSCC) is investigating an accident at the Canaport LNG site that claimed the life of a 44-year-old worker on Wednesday, January 30.

It appears that the worker fell from elevation while working on a gondola beneath an overhead crane.

WHSCC officers were dispatched as soon as the accident was reported, and are still investigating to determine whether there were violations to the *Occupational Health and Safety Act.* At this time, no orders have been written or charges laid.
